Beats

Steps

1&2    Shuffle to R side R-L-R  
&3&4   Pivot 1/4 turn R, step L forward, lock R behind L, step L forward  
          (The next 4 counts are a Monterey Turn)  
&5-6   Turn 1/4 turn L, touch R toe to R side, step R beside L turning 1/2 turn R  
7-8    Touch L toe to L side, step L beside R

(The next 4 counts travel on diagonals)

1&2    Slide R forward & across L, lock L behind R, slide R forward  
3&4    Slide L forward & across R, lock R behind L, slide L forward  
5-7    Step R across L, step L across R, step R across L (Sassy Walk Forward)  
8       Pivot 1/2 turn R on R foot dragging L toe drawing a circle

The next 4 counts travel on diagonals)

1&2    Slide L forward & across R, lock R behind L, slide L forward  
3&4    Slide R forward & across L, lock L behind R, slide R forward  
5-6    Step L forward turning 1/2 turn R, pivot on L 1/2 turn R stepping forward on R  
7-8    Step L forward, tap R beside L

1-2    Twisting L heel to R touch R toe forward, step R beside L twisting L heel to  
          centre  
3-4    Twisting R heel to R, touch L toe back, step L beside R twisting R heel to  
          centre  
5-8    Repeat above 4 counts (Washing machine twists)

1&2    Step R across L, step L to L side, step R across L  
3&4    Step L to L side, step R behind L, step L to L side turning 1/4 turn L  
5-6    Step R forward, pivot on R 3/4 turn L stepping onto L foot  
7&8    Step R across L, step L to L side, step R across L

1&2    Step L across R, step R to R side, step L across R  
3&4    Step R to R side, step L behind R, step R to R side turning 1/4 turn R  
5-6    Step L forward, pivot 3/4 turn R stepping onto R foot  
7&8    Step in place L-R-L turning 1/2 turn R
